THE OPPORTUNITY

The Go Global Internship is a 10-12 month opportunity for individuals to engage in God's purposes around the world by empowering them to live out the Great Commission in the unique way God has called them. These individuals are sent to established, overseas missions organizations for the purpose of serving their mission, immersing themselves into the lives of those in the community, and ultimately sharing the love of Jesus with the lost and hurting of the world. This opportunity is for those who are ready to serve and love people, have been trained by their local church, are financially, spiritually and physically healthy, have a passion to reach the world, and want to pursue the possibility of serving as a career missionary.

THE REQUIREMENTS

This opportunity is for those who are serious about international missions and willing to go the distance to make a difference. Thus, there are some specific requirements:

- A heart for international missions;
- Holistic health (*ready spiritually, relationally, mentally, financially, physically*);
- Trained for at least one year in an approved Bible college/school of ministry/local church internship (*check with Go Global staff if unsure if your experience is approved*);
- Has had an international missions experience prior to applying;
- Flexibility and ability to work well with others and operate under authority;
- Willingness to serve under the vision of the missions organization to which you are sent and meet the Go Global requirements established at that destination;
- Able to fully commit to the program for the full 10-12 months;
- Completion and submission of Go Global Engage Internship Application by the stated deadline; and
- Able to travel to Baton Rouge, LA or Memphis, TN for an interview and training with Go Global

THE COST

Estimated cost \$15,000 - \$20,000

*Must have all funds before you leave.

*Some countries may be more or less.

Cost includes: airfare, travel insurance, lodging, cell phone, ground transportation, stipend for personal expenses, and visa.

Here are some things that are not included in the above budget that you will need to consider:

Immunizations

Personal Laptop Computer (not required, but helpful)

Storage (for personal affects in the states)

Personal Debt

Additional Insurance Policies (life, etc.)

Car Payments

Self-Employment Taxes

Vehicle (some of our overseas partners ask that you purchase a vehicle)

Once the program participants are determined, Go Global will work with each individual to develop a customized budget, taking into account additional personal needs. The total of these additional financial needs will be added to the program costs to create your total fundraising goal.

All interns should successfully complete extensive fundraising elements and meet set financial goals prior to departure.

THE OPTIONS

- **Healing Place Church and Children's Cup International Relief - Mbabane, Swaziland**

Healing Place Church (HPC) and Children's Cup partner to serve the people of Swaziland. HPC is a pioneering church with a "vision to be a healing place for a hurting world." This year, HPC will plant a church in Mbabane, Swaziland alongside a thriving Children's Cup care point. This and other Children's Cup care points currently meet the needs of Swazi children through daily meals, Bible Clubs, basic medical care, leadership development, education and many other life-giving ministries. In Swaziland you will have the opportunity to serve the church and care point ministries as they reach the Swazi people for Jesus.

- **Kampala Pentecostal Church and Watoto Child Care Ministries - Kampala, Uganda**

God is using Kampala Pentecostal Church (KPC) and Watoto to change the future of Uganda. Through Watoto, KPC's flourishing community seed project, the church is caring for thousands of orphaned children. The mission of Watoto is to "raise the next generation of Ugandan leaders by placing parentless children in families where the necessary love, care, discipleship and physical needs are provided." Gary and Marilyn Skinner established the church in 1984, and now minister to thousands across five celebration points and multiple outreaches in addition to Watoto Child Care Ministries. JMM's radio and TV broadcasts are aired daily throughout the entire nation, reaching millions of listeners who are transformed through the preaching of God's Word. Practical needs are being met as well. Feeding programs, micro-finance initiatives, kids' camps, medical missions and many more ministries operate daily, making an eternal impact. As an intern in India, you will be given the opportunity to serve in one of several ministry areas - from graphic design and media to church planting and Bible schools and everything in between.

THE EVERYDAY

As an *Engage* intern, you will be fully devoted to serving the partner ministry to which you are assigned. Schedules will look slightly different depending on the ministry you serve. Go Global will work with each partner to create a weekly schedule for you during your 10-12 months of service. Your experience will include at least 35-40 hours of service each week. Your specific function and job description will be determined primarily by the needs of the ministry. Consideration will also be given to your skills, experience and strengths.

Additionally, intentional discipleship is a core element of the internship program. This will include small group meetings surrounding an in-country training curriculum, purposeful, daily devotional time, and one-on-one meetings with your Internship Director to develop a personal growth plan for your time in the *Engage* program. This aspect of the program will serve also to help you process life in a new culture and explore how God might be speaking to you about your involvement in overseas ministry following the internship.

Specific living conditions will vary by location, however, please know that Go Global makes every effort to place interns in comfortable, clean and safe housing. Housing will be quite different than what you find in the United States, but we do want to set you up for success in the new environment.

THE QUESTIONS - FAQs

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IF I AM ACCEPTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GO GLOBAL INTERNSHIP, AM I EXPECTED TO BECOME A LONG-TERM MISSIONARY FOLLOWING THE 10-12 MONTH COMMITMENT?

No. Your commitment is for 10-12 months only. If you are interested in long-term opportunities, a separate process will follow the internship. Participation in the Go Global Internship does not commit you to anything beyond the 10-12 month time period.

HOW WILL MY FINANCES BE ADMINISTERED?

Pledged payments should be sent to and handled through Go Global. Go Global will then administer disbursements to you and the partner ministry to cover your costs of living while in-country. It is each intern's responsibility to make arrangements for financial needs beyond the program costs. Go Global will not administer those finances; however, we will assist each intern with complete budget development.

WHAT ARE THE RULES ON DATING?

Go Global is designed to create an environment for interns to cultivate significant growth in their relationship with God. All of the requirements and rules established in Go Global are to help foster a focused period of time to seek the heart of God in all areas of one's life. As such we ask that interns do not start new dating relationships during their time in the Go Global Internship.

CAN MY FRIENDS AND FAMILY COME TO VISIT ME?

They can only visit within a Go Global set time - all friends and family can come at that one time. Those times will be announced at a later date and will be determined by the needs of the Global Ministry Partner and the seasonal needs of their ministries.

CAN I RETURN TO THE STATES FOR A VISIT DURING THE INTERNSHIP?

No, return trips to the U.S. will not be allowed due to the brief nature of the program and the problems interruptions may cause for the Global Ministry Partner and the intern's adjustment. Family emergencies in the United States will be reviewed and considered case by case. If you know of something for which you will need to return to the States, please consider deferring until you are able to participate in the program without interruption.

DO I GET TO CHOOSE WHERE I WILL SERVE?

Each intern's preference will be taken into account when determining placement. However, many other factors also will be considered when making these decisions, including the skills and competencies of each intern and how they compliment the needs of each partner. Ultimately, Go Global, our Global Ministry Partners and your local pastor will make the final decision on assignments.

WHAT IF I GET SICK OR HURT?

All medical issues will be taken very seriously by Go Global. We want to ensure that you receive the best medical attention available in the case of illness and emergency. Your wishes and the recommendation of your doctor will be primary considerations prior to repatriation to the U.S. If you have specific concerns about these types of matters, please don't hesitate to contact us.

HOW DO I TALK TO MY FAMILY ABOUT APPLYING FOR THE ENGAGE INTERNSHIP?

Each family is different and, therefore, will react differently to the news of your application to the *Engage* program. If you are concerned and would like advice on how to approach this subject with your family, we encourage you to discuss your situation with your Ministry School director and/or your pastor. Mentors and ministry leaders with whom you are in relationship will be best suited to give you counsel on such matters.

Generally, Go Global advises parents and concerned relatives to read the *Engage* "Letter to Parents". This letter can be found on the Go Global website and hopefully will address and answer some of their concerns.

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT AFTER I TURN IN MY APPLICATION?

Receipt of your application will be acknowledged immediately. Subsequently, you will be contacted with details of the scheduled interview with Go Global. **All applicants will be expected to travel to Memphis, TN or Baton Rouge, LA for an interview with Go Global.** Details will follow.

WHEN WILL I BE NOTIFIED OF THE STATUS OF MY APPLICATION?

You will be notified by July 1 for the Winter Launch Team and January 1 for the Summer Launch Team.

THE BEYOND

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I FINISH?

At the close of your 10-12 month experience, you will return home. *Engage* is designed to enable people who are interested in missions to explore the possibility of serving overseas long-term. If you feel called to return to the mission field long-term, a separate process will follow. The preparation process for *Engage* is not designed to prepare you for a long-term experience. Upon completion of *Engage*, Go Global, our Global Ministry Partners, the intern's ministry leaders and each intern will work collaboratively to determine the best next step for long-term success.

Confirmation of the call to missions should be confirmed by your pastor. The support of your local church is a requirement for going long-term.

THE APPLICATION

You will note this is a very detailed and extensive survey regarding many aspects of your personal life and beliefs. *Engage* is a strategic platform for meeting the needs of our partners, exposing those interested in missions to a substantial experience and sharing the love of Christ to the hurting and lost. To ensure this is effectively done, we must attempt to address any concerns prior to departure that might affect your experience and/or the team. Please be honest in your answers and address all questions outlined on the form. Feel free to attach additional answer sheets as necessary. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact Go Global. Once your application is received, you will be contacted to set up an interview in Memphis, TN or Baton Rouge, LA.

GO GLOBAL'S CODE OF CONDUCT

One of Go Global's most important goals for each intern is to facilitate the growth and development of Christian character and leadership in line with Biblical principles. It is expected that Go Global interns live in such a manner that brings glory to God in their behavior and attitudes in all manners of life. Therefore, interns are expected to follow codes of conduct that should not be taken legalistically, but as boundaries for protection and integrity while in the Engage internship. Therefore each intern is expected to:

- Abstain from Biblically immoral practices including drunkenness, stealing, slanderous or profane language, dishonesty, occult practices and sexual sins (premarital sex, adultery and homosexuality) or any other behavior that is considered detrimental to Christian character and witness. Interns are expected to refrain from any alcoholic beverage and bar/club while in the Go Global Internship.
- Avoid attitudes (such as greed, jealousy, pride, bitterness, needless anger, and discrimination) and behavior (such as gossip, divisiveness, and complaining) that disrupts the unity and health of the church body, team and organization you serve.
- Show respect for missionaries and workers and co-operate with the aims and endeavors of Go Global.
- Attend all prescribed classes, ministry sessions, and activities required by the Engage Internship unless formally excused.
- Submit all assignment work by the due dates.
- Be neat, clean, and modestly dressed according to the standards of Christians in the culture in which you live.
- Do not get piercings, tattoos, and etc. while in Engage Internship due to cultural norms in the countries in which you will live.
- Do not begin any form of dating relationship while in the Engage program.

Go Global will provide the framework and support needed to bring personal growth. If you find, however, that you are genuinely struggling with such issues, we advise that you speak to Go Global staff and allow them to bring guidance, counsel and correction to your situation. Any behavior that contravenes the Intern Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary action and may lead to removal from the Go Global Internship, including premature repatriation to the United States.

GO GLOBAL'S BELIEFS & VALUES

WHAT WE BELIEVE...

ABOUT THE BIBLE:

We believe the Holy Bible, both the Old and New Testaments, is the authoritative Word of God. It alone is the final authority for determining all doctrinal truths. In its original writing, the Bible is inspired, infallible and inerrant.

ABOUT GOD:

We believe there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son (Jesus Christ) and Holy Spirit. These three are coequal and coeternal.

ABOUT JESUS:

We believe Jesus Christ is God the Son, the second person of the Trinity. On earth, Jesus was 100% God and 100% man. He was born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, performed miracles, died on the cross for humanity and thus, atoned for our sins through the shedding of His blood. We believe Jesus Christ was conceived by God the Father, through the Holy Spirit, in the Virgin Mary's womb; therefore, He is the Son of God. We believe Jesus Christ was physically resurrected from the dead in a glorified body three days after His death on the cross, and ascended into heaven where He sits at the right hand of the Father.

ABOUT MAN:

We believe man was created in the image of God, but through voluntary disobedience sinned and fell. Consequently, all of humanity shares in man's lost and sinful nature, and humanity's only hope for redemption is in Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

ABOUT SALVATION:

We believe man is saved by grace alone, through personal faith in Jesus Christ. Salvation is a gift from God, not a result of our good works or of any human effort. Through repentance of our sins, we receive forgiveness of our sins. Repentance is the commitment to turn away from sin in every area of our lives and to follow Jesus Christ, thus allowing us to be redeemed.

ABOUT SANCTIFICATION:

We believe in sanctification, the ongoing process of yielding to God's Word and the Holy Spirit in order to complete the development of Christ's character in us. It is through the present ministry of the Holy Spirit and the Word of God that the Christian is enabled to live a godly life.

ABOUT BAPTISM WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT:

We believe the baptism with the Holy Spirit, given at Pentecost, is the promise of the Father for all believers as a definite endowment of power for service and is subsequent to, and separate from, salvation.

ABOUT SPIRITUAL GIFTS:

We believe the Holy Spirit is manifested through a variety of spiritual gifts to build and sanctify the church, demonstrate the validity of the resurrection and confirm the power of the gospel. The lists of these gifts in the Bible are not necessarily exhaustive and may occur in various combinations. These gifts always operate in harmony with the Word of God and should never be used in violation of biblical parameters.

ABOUT ORDINANCES OF THE CHURCH:
